Geometry: Angles

Identifying right, acute and obtuse angles. Using a protractor to measure angles. Drawing lines and angles accurately by using a protractor and a ruler. Learning to recognise and name different types of triangles and quadrilaterals. Continue working on instant recall of the multiplication facts.

Reading: Robinson Crusoe Activities: story maps, captions, character studies, writing for different purposes, sequencing main events, writing sentences and paragraphs, diary writing. Daily guided reading. Grammar: Using relative clauses beginning with who, which, where, when, whose, that. Increasing familiarity with a wide range of books. Continue to learn spelling words including words with silent letters and homophones.

Science

Forces: Learning about contact and non contact forces. Comparing how objects move on different surfaces. Observing how magnets attract objects and identifying some magnetic materials. Recognising that some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect. Learning that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity.
