Maths
Number and Place Value
 This half term, we will revise numbers to 20 and the children will be able to understand the amounts that are represented by each numeral. We will be looking at counting to and across 20, 50 and 100. Learners will develop their skills in using pictorial representations such as number lines, place value charts and part whole models.

English
All About Me
 In Phonics the children will be Class texts: We Are All Wonders, Hair Love, Grandad Island, The Day the Crayons Quit
Activities:
 The class will be describing characters and sequence events of stories. We will continue to write sentences using Shape Coding. They will be using the conjunction 'and' to extend sentences. They will read compound words and understand how they are formed.
