

Maths:

English Reading: We will read: Noah Scape, *Me and My Sister*, *A friend for Henry*, We will practise our phonics daily, read using our prior knowledge and work on knowing, reoccurring language, phrases and detail, in sotires,

Writing: We will write autobiographies, biographies and recounts of experiences. We will learn to use conjunctions and punctuation, sequence events, and orally rehearsing different sentences.. We will practice the alphabet, high frequency words, and year 1 spellings.

How to help: Adding 's' / 'es/ed' to the end of words, writing sentences describing events now and in the past, using expanded noun phrases, using 'I' and conjunctions, and using capital letters, full stops and question and punctuation marks.
