Maths Addition and Subtraction The children will add an subtract 1 and 2-digit numbers up to 20. They will become more confident in adding subtracting mentally. The children will recognise and use inverse relationships between addition and subtraction and use this

Computing Computer Science Students will continue to develop their coding skills by using scratch software to programme. English Everyday Life/ Pets Class texts: Who Wants a Dog? There's a Snake in My School 100 Dogs and 100 Cats. The children will continue to learn new phonics sounds and use their knowledge to read and spell words. The class will learn about past tense verbs (both regular and irregular). They will learn to write the names of the days using capital letters. They will describe story characters using adjectives..

Science Everyday Materials Identifying and naming a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal. Comparing and grouping together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties. The children will make suggestions about which materials to use for different purposes.
