fact file	A <b>fact file</b> is a document that details the characteristics or functions of a certain object.	









Key word	Definition	Visual
mini-beasts	<b>Mini-beats</b> are small invertebrate animals such as an insect or spider.	
insects	<b>Insects</b> are small invertebrate animals with antennae, three pairs of legs and two pairs of wings.	
habitats	The type of environment in which an organism or group normally lives or occurs.	
bees	Bees are yellow and black flying insects that make honey and can sting you.	
bee hive	A dome-shaped or boxlike structure in which bees are kept.	



honey bees	A type of bee that collects nectar and pollen, produces wax and honey.	
the environment	The area in which something exists or lives.	
recycling	The act of processing used or abandoned materials for use in creating new products.	
re-usable	Able to be used again or more than once.	
plants	<b>Plants</b> are living beings: they are born, feed, grow, breathe, reproduce its composed of roots, stems, and leaves. In addition, many of them have flowers, fruits and seeds.	
growing	Growing is the increasing in size or quantity or becoming greater over a period of time.	
trees	A woody plant, typically having a single stem or trunk, growing to a considerable height and bearing lateral branches at some distance from the ground.	

weather	The mix of events that happen each day in our atmosphere.	
sunshine	The warmth and light given by the sun's rays.	
rain	The condensed moisture of the atmosphere falling in drops.	
wind	The <b>wind</b> is the perceptible natural movement of the air.	
thunder	A <b>thunder</b> is a loud rumbling or crashing noise heard after a lightning flash.	
lightning	<b>Lightning</b> is electrical discharge caused by storm clouds and the ground, or within the clouds themselves.	
cold	At a low temperature, especially when compared with the human body.	
hot	Having a high degree of heat or a high temperature.	






drawing	A picture or diagram made with a pencil, pen, or crayon rather than paint.	






paint brush	A brush used to apply paint or ink.	
collage	A paste-up made by sticking together pieces of paper or photographs to form an artistic image.	





Blue zone	The Blue Zone is used to describe <b>low states of alertness</b> , such as when one feels sad, tired, sick, or bored.	 BLUE ZONE
Green zone	The Green Zone is used <b>to describe a calm state of alertness</b> . A person may be described as happy, focused, content, or ready to learn when in the Green Zone. Being in the Green Zone will help students be successful in the classroom.	 GREEN ZONE

Yellow zone	The Yellow Zone is also used to describe <b>a heightened state of alertness and elevated emotions</b> ; however, one has some control when they are in the Yellow Zone. A person may be experiencing stress, frustration, anxiety, excitement, silliness, the wiggles, or nervousness when in the Yellow Zone.	 <p>YELLOW ZONE</p>
Red zone	The Red Zone is used to describe extremely heightened <b>states of alertness and intense emotions</b> . A person may be elated or experiencing anger, rage, explosive behavior, devastation, or terror when in the Red Zone.	 <p>RED ZONE</p>

falling out	A quarrel or disagreement.	
making up	Solving a disagreement or making up after an argument.	
friendship	The state or feeling of being friends; I value our friendship over everything else.
