







suffix	A suffix is added to a word to make a new word.	






exclamation	An exclamation is a sentence that shows strong feelings or excitement.

plural noun	More than one person, place or thing.	







Maths: Fractions

environment	The environment includes everything living and non-living.	






food sources	Different sources that provide food for humans and animals.





