exclamation mark	An exclamation mark ends that sentence that shows a strong feeling or excitement.	








## Maths: Measurement

prey	An animal that is hunted by other animals for food.	



instruction	Something someone tells you to do.	







saving	Setting aside money for future use instead of spending it immediately.	












key	A symbol that shows an important landmark, place or area.	





honesty	Telling the truth.	






