lightning	<b>Lightning</b> is electrical discharge caused by storm clouds and the ground, or within the clouds themselves.	












Key word	Definition	Visual
Blue zone	The Blue Zone is used to describe <b>low states of alertness</b> , such as when one feels sad, tired, sick, or bored.	 <p>BLUE ZONE</p>




Green zone	The Green Zone is used to describe a <b>calm state of alertness</b> . A person may be described as happy, focused, content, or ready to learn when in the Green Zone. Being in the Green Zone will help students be successful in the classroom.	
Yellow zone	The Yellow Zone is also used to describe a <b>heightened state of alertness and elevated emotions</b> ; however, one has some control when they are in the Yellow Zone. A person may be experiencing stress, frustration, anxiety, excitement, silliness, the wiggles, or nervousness when in the Yellow Zone.	
Red zone	The Red Zone is used to describe extremely heightened <b>states of alertness and intense emotions</b> . A person may be elated or experiencing anger, rage, explosive behavior, devastation, or terror when in the Red Zone.

falling out	A quarrel or disagreement.	

making up	Solving a disagreement or making up after an argument.	
friendship	The state or feeling of being friends; I value our friendship over everything else.
