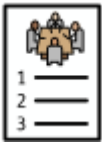




School Council Meeting - Summer 1 - 25th April 2024

Agenda:

- Welcome** - PJ welcomed all school councillors. School councillors introduced themselves and the class they were representing. PJ sent apologies for James and Alissa.
- Fish tank set up** - The school council were informed that the fish tank has been successfully set up with fish, and this was partially responsible for James sharing his disappointment at the long process at the previous meeting. School councillors were happy that their voices were heard.
- Enrichment ideas** - PJ shared that we wanted to freshen up the enrichment ideas for next term. PJ said that at the moment they were all very sporty and if someone doesn't like sports, there's not a lot for them to choose. School councillors agreed with this and began to suggest some more ideas; debating/ politics, Nintendo Wii, Boxing, Hockey. PJ shared that during exams the KS3 classes will relocate from the corridor so there may be some room changes.
