

Termly Curriculum overview

Class: Comets

Term: Spring 1

Maths

The class will be doing simple calculations with two numbers. The children will be adding and subtracting numbers using objects, pictorial representations and mentally.

They will learn that addition of two numbers can be done in any order and subtraction from one number from another cannot.

English

Topic books: A christmas story, Nutcracker, The gruffalo, Going on a bear hunt.

The children will look at writing their own narratives and writing a letter which they will then post.

The children will continue to learn new phonics sounds and use their knowledge to read and spell words.

Science

The focus in science this half term will be on animals. They children will be able to name a variety of animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. The children will be able to discuss what they eat (carnivore, herbivore and omnivore).

They will be able to sort animals into categories (including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals).

They will be able to sort living and nonliving things.

Geography

Children will be learning about North, East, West and South.

They will look at different continents, oceans in and the UK. They will learn about human and physical features and draw a map

History

The children will be able to recognise objects from the past. They will be able to comment on their changes from birth. They will be able to discuss how others have helped us in the past. They will be able to talk about the past and present in their own lives.

DT

This term the children will be learning about how to stay safe in the kitchen and where food comes from. With support they will be preparing a range of simple healthy lunch dishes. They will be working on improving fine motor, mixing and cutting skills.

PE

This term the pupils will be doing gymnastics. They will explore a range of ways their bodies can move to a stimulus and how to sequence movements. They will work on skills such as balance and how to safely use different apparatus.

ART Painting Skills

Children will be learning how to use poster paint. Skills will include holding a paintbrush correctly. They will revise primary colours and experiment with how to mix secondary colours. They will also learn how to clean brushes and pallets.

PSHE

In pshe we will be discussing personal hygiene with a focus on brushing teeth. The children will learn to make simple choices that improve their health and well-being.

They will practice asking for help from adults when something is wrong.

Computing

Digital Literacy- Comets will learn to use their keyboard and mouse properly and will practice typing through different games and softwares.

Music: Topics: Pitch and exploring sounds.

The students will develop understanding of pitch through using movement, voices and instruments. The children will use voices, movement and instruments to explore different ways that music can be used to describe the weather.

RE

The children will be able to talk about similarities and differences between themselves and others, among families, communities and traditions.
