





## School Council Meeting - Autumn 2 - 4th/5th December

### Agenda:

<p>1. <b>Welcome</b></p> <p>PJ welcomed all school councillors and congratulated them on being elected by their class groups. Each councillor introduced themselves and stated which class they represented. PJ explained that, due to logistical reasons, this term's meetings are being held separately for primary and secondary. He assured councillors that future meetings will be combined.</p>	
<p>2. <b>School Development Priorities goal</b></p> <p>PJ presented a pupil-friendly version of the school development priorities. School councillors discussed them and agreed that the priorities were appropriate and important for continued school improvement.</p>	
<p>3. <b>Pupil Survey</b></p> <p>PJ shared the upcoming pupil survey and explained that school councillors will be responsible for distributing it to their classes and encouraging classmates to complete it. Councillors will also explain the purpose of the survey to their peers. The survey should be completed before half term.</p>	
<p>4. <b>Behaviour</b></p> <p>PJ updated councillors on planned changes to the current Dojo behaviour system to make it more motivating.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Primary councillors</b> gave positive feedback on their new class rewards, saying they liked being able to work together as a class to earn more exciting rewards.</li> <li>• <b>Secondary councillors</b> shared that the current system does not always motivate them to follow the Capella Values. They noted that it can sometimes feel more like a competition between pupils rather than personal motivation. And they shared that even if they get the most dojo points they still may not win the prize. Secondary councillors liked the new tiered system and offered several suggestions for rewards they felt would be more motivating.</li> </ul>	

<p><b>5. Any Other Business (AOB) suggestions</b></p> <p><b>Primary councillors</b> suggested introducing “Taco Tuesday” and raised the topic of bullying. They reported, however, that they feel safe in school.</p> <p><b>Secondary councillors</b> requested a wider range of snacks to support regulation strategies and suggested having more mufti days. They also raised the issue that the second-floor water fountain has been out of action for a year.</p>	
<p><b>6. Actions</b></p> <p>School councillors to share the pupil survey form with their form groups,</p> <p>PJ to speak to premises to chase the water fountain being fixed at Secondary.</p>
