

Termly Curriculum overview

Class: Galaxy

Term: spring 2

Maths: Multiplication and division

Students will learn about multiplication and division. Children will start by counting in 2s, 5s and 10s before moving on to recognising groups and making equal groups when giving certain amounts. Students will then learn the foundations of division as sharing equally and will use their knowledge of equal groups to share certain amounts.

English

We will continue to explore creative writing and stories using structured narrative and speech. We will also use and create non-fiction books. We will look at the following grammatical features: question marks and exclamation marks and function of different types of sentences ,homophones, syllables , word families and spelling rules to pluralise words and make comparison.We will also work on and common exception words when reading and linking aspects of stories to our lives and expressing and knowledge and ideas about stories.

Science - sound

We will be learning about the concept of sound and sound waves and we will explore how they travel and how we hear sounds with our ear.We will conduct observations to see representations of sound waves and we investigate different sounds. We will also create our own model of a speaker and our own harmonica to make and transport different sounds.

Geography:

Geography:
Regions :The Alps and Snowdonia- : We will use maps and atlases to explore Europe, Switzerland and the U.K. We will use pictures and non-fiction texts to learn about the physical and human geography of the two regions. We will also explore similarities and differences between them and we will learn about the local jobs, infrastructure, cities, towns and villages and we will explore how an area has developed.

History - History: Invaders and settlers

The Vikings: We will create timelines of invasions and settlements in the UK and we explore Viking invasions, homes, farming, trade, exploration, society and ships.. We will learn about the Battle of Stamford Bridge. Lindisfarne Monastery, King Alfred's peace and Athelstan and other Anglo-Saxons kings reclaiming of land and Eric Bloodaxe.

DT

This term Galaxy will be looking at Kitchen Safety, where food comes from and food groups. They will be following step by step instructions and increasing their independence with cooking skills by leaning to prepare range of Healthy Lunches.

PE

In Galaxy Class, we will introduce invasion games through simple team-building activities that build confidence and cooperation. Pupils will learn to communicate, share space, and support one another in a positive and inclusive environment.

ART - Collage

Children will be introduced to a range of collage techniques and will experiment with cutting, ripping and tearing to produce artwork inspired by Giuseppe Arcimboldo

PSHE: NSPCC: Speak Out. Stay Safe

They will be learning about different situations including: Physical and verbal and sexual abuse, neglect and bullying all within age appropriate language and context.

Computing

Computing:
Students will learn how to use presentation software to present information that they have researched.

Music:

The students will focus on singing. Learning how to warm up their voices and learning about pitch and rhythm. The children will practice and learn a class song.
