

Termly Curriculum overview

Class: Satellite

Term: Spring 2

Maths

This half term, Satellite class will continue to develop their addition and subtraction skills focusing on exchange. We will also be exploring how to solve addition and subtraction word problems.

English

Reading: The Stinky Cheese Man and other fairly stupid fairy tales and The Lorax

We will continue to explore creative writing and stories using structured narrative and speech. They will be exploring grammar such as exclamation marks, expanded noun phrases, homophones, pre-fixes and suffixes and sequencing events in a text. We will also work on and common exception words when reading and linking aspects of stories to our lives and expressing and knowledge and ideas about stories.

Science

Topic: Sound
We will be learning about the concept of sound and sound waves and we will explore how they travel and how we hear sounds with our ear. We will conduct observations to see representations of sound waves and we investigate different sounds. We will also create our own model of a speaker and our own harmonica to make and transport different sounds.

Geography

Satellites are learning about volcanoes and earthquakes. Students will explore what volcanoes and earthquakes are and why they happen. They will learn how these natural events can change the Earth and discuss simple ways to stay safe. Students will also learn what to do before, during, and after an earthquake or volcanic eruption.

History

Satellite class will look at Viking invaders and learn how Britain changed under their occupation.

DT

This term pupils will be reviewing Kitchen Safety including hygiene. They will explore different food groups. They will be continuing to increase their independence with cooking skills by preparing a range of healthy breakfasts.

PE

In PE this term the pupils will be having swimming lessons at Teddington Pool. The children will be building their confidence in the water and learn about pool safety. They will practice a range of different strokes and learn about breath control.

ART

Drawing Skills
Pupils will continue to develop their understanding of different mark making techniques. They will explore tone using chalk and charcoal.

PSHE: NSPCC: Speak Out. Stay Safe

They will be learning about different situations including: Physical and verbal and sexual abuse, neglect and bullying all within age appropriate language and context.

Computing

Satellites are learning about digital devices and how they work. Students will also learn how devices can connect to share information and name some basic parts of digital devices using simple computing words.

Music

This year Satellite will be exploring the 5 key components of music: tempo, duration and texture through different genres and pieces of music.
