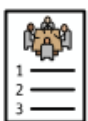







School Council Meeting - Spring 1 - Friday 27th March

Agenda:

<p>1. Welcome</p> <p>PJ welcomed all school councillors. PJ explained that, due to logistical reasons, this term's meetings are being held separately for primary and secondary. Courtney (Mercury rep) had sent her apologies and wouldn't be attending the meeting as was attending an important lesson that couldn't be missed.</p>	
<p>2. Behaviour feedback</p> <p>PJ asked for school council feedback on the recent changes to the reward system. School councillors shared that whilst the changes were positive, the dojo points targets were too ambitious. PJ agreed with this and new points targets will be made for the summer term to ensure more pupils can achieve the silver and gold awards.</p> <p>School councillors said that there had been positive changes in behaviour at Capella Secondary, and that on the whole pupils were more settled and engaged.</p>	
<p>3. Anti-bullying action plan</p> <p>PJ shared the results from the autumn term pupil surveys. The school councillors agreed that most of the responses were positive. However, they noticed that about 20% of pupils said they either didn't know or did not feel safe at school. This was discussed as an important issue.</p> <p>PJ reminded everyone about the anti-bullying action plan that is already in place. The school councillors agreed that this is a good plan and supported it. PJ also asked the councillors to think about who could be chosen as <i>Kindness Ambassadors</i> (pupils who would spot and celebrate acts of kindness around the school.)</p> <p>School councillors will think about this and share their ideas at the next meeting.</p>	

<p>4. Breaktime</p> <p>PJ asked the school councillors to talk to their form groups to find out their thoughts on breaktime and how they would improve it to support engagement and enjoyment.</p>	
<p>5. Any Other Business (AOB)</p> <p>School councillors said the recent ketchup now being used by the kitchen wasn't nice, and they wanted it changed to the old one. PJ suggested school councillors should write a letter to the catering team.</p> <p>School councillors also suggested new cricket balls being bought.</p> <p>School councillors would like badges which identify them as school councillors.</p>	
<p>6. Actions</p> <p>School councillors to nominate different kindness ambassadors during the next meeting.</p> <p>School councillors to draft a letter to the catering team regarding the change of ketchup,</p>
